- 1. Students must complete 140 credits, which include 30 credits of "University Required Credits," 18 credits of "College Core Courses s," 60 credits of "Departmental Core Courses," 24 credits of "Credits in internship," and 8 credits from one of the department's "Department Professional Program."
- 2. The department offers two "Department Professional Program": the "Long-Term Care Occupational Therapy Program" and the "Occupational Therapy for Children." Each program consists of 8 credits. To ensure that students have acquired comprehensive knowledge before the clinical internship and the national licensing exam, it is recommended that students complete all courses marked [National Licensing and Clinical Internship Related Courses] under their selected Specialized Elective Program prior to the internship. Courses taken from the other Specialized Elective Program may count as "Department Elective Courses," but cannot be double-counted towards the credits of the primary program.
- 3. "Cultivation Education" is a required component of the general education curriculum. Undergraduate students must participate in at least 8 activities during their studies (2 in Healthy, 2 in Care, 2 in Innovation, and 2 in Excellence) and complete an assessment of learning outcomes. The results are graded as P/F (Pass/Fail), but these credits do not count towards the general elective credits or the minimum graduation credits.
- 4. Students who need to apply for credit transfer, credit reduction, or retake courses must follow the school's schedule and regulations for adding and dropping courses each semester, as well as the department's "Asia University Department of Occupational Therapy Professional Course Add/Drop Application Form" and "Asia University Department of Occupational Therapy Course Add/Drop Procedure Chart." Failure to comply may result in the inability to add/drop courses or have credits recognized.
- 5. All required professional courses must be passed to qualify for participation in clinical internship.
